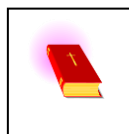

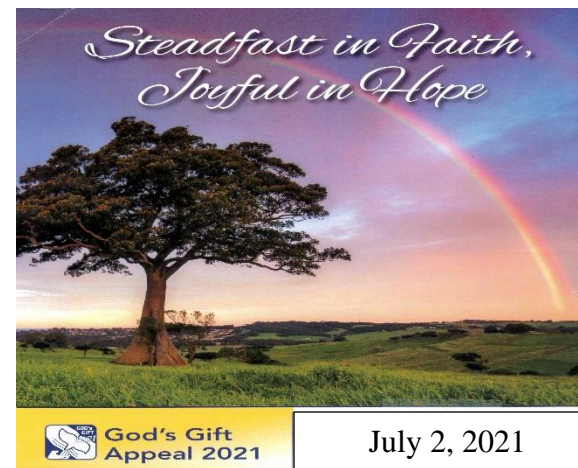
WEEKLY PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL PETITIONS: That we may learn from the Apostles to give up our strong attachment to material possessions.
