MENTORS NEEDED FOR OUR YOUTH: The CYO program purchased a new curriculum for our 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders. In this program, there will be a teacher for the whole class (Kevin Wolsky). Then there will be mentors for students to break off in groups after the group lesson. As a church, we are looking for people to step up and **become a mentor for our youth.** This would mean you would sit in and take part in the Wednesday class with our 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> grade students. The program is called "Life Teen" and it helps the kids see and put their faith into action.

AWARD TRIP: Our CCD and CYO students and parents this year have an amazing opportunity to go to Valley Fair and a Twins game. To obtain this opportunity, the students in Preschool-12 have to do some work. Preschool through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade must attend Kids and the Gospel or fill out the Kids and the Gospel sheets in the back of the church. 4<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade must fill out the homily notes sheet. This is just like last year with one exception. At least one parent must attend Mass with their child and sign the homily notes sheet, or the Kids and the Gospel sheet, attesting to this. The top 10 students and their parents with the best attendance record will go on the trip. Ties are accepted. Students can go to any Catholic church. Because of the specialness of this trip, NO allowances will be accepted, medical or otherwise.

Reminder: All of these sheets no matter what grade must have a parent/guardian AND student signatures or they do not count and need to be turned in on a weekly basis.
