### HOLY THURSDAY

Practice for the servers for Holy Thursday will be Wednesday, March 31<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 p.m.

#### **Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 p.m. (PLEASE NOTE THE NEW TIME)**

(At the Last Supper, on the night He was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of His body and blood.) I. Liturgy of the Word and the Washing of the Feet. II. Re-commissioning of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. III. Liturgy of the Eucharist and the transfer of the Holy Eucharist to the social hall. There will be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the social hall until 10:00 p.m.

### GOOD FRIDAY (DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE)

#### **Celebration of the Lord's Passion at 12:00 Noon. (Sykeston 3:00 p.m.)**

According to ancient tradition, Mass is not celebrated today. The celebration of the Lord's Passion consists of three parts: I. Liturgy of the Word. II. Veneration of the Cross. III. Holy Communion.



### HOLY SATURDAY (EASTER VIGIL)

Practice for the servers for Holy Saturday will be Saturday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10:00 a.m.

#### **Vigil of the Lord's Resurrection at 8:30 p.m.**

The Easter Vigil is arranged into four parts: I. After a brief service of light; II. The Church meditates on all the wonderful things God has done for His people from the beginning - this is the Liturgy of the Word. III. As the day of resurrection approaches, the water is blessed for the sprinkling rite. Also, we renew our baptismal promises and candidates are confirmed. IV. The whole Church is called to the altar which the Lord prepared for His people through His death and resurrection - this is the Liturgy of the Eucharist.



You are also invited to bring your containers to take home Holy Water from the Holy Water basin in the sacristy.
