**UPDATES ON DEFERRED ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS (DACA) PROGRAM**

After a federal court ordered DHS to reinstate the DACA program on December 4, 2020, the USCIS website was updated to confirm that first time requests for DACA consideration are being accepted – effective December 7, 2020. Applications for DACA renewal continue to be accepted, and would be granted for two-year periods. Applications for advance parole (permission to travel) for DACA recipients are also being accepted.
