WEEKDAY MASSES/SACRAMENTS INSIDE CHURCH BEGINNING MONDAY, MARCH 8

Beginning Monday, March 8th we will be celebrating the weekday Masses (8am and 6:30pm) as well as the 5:30pm Saturday Vigil Mass in the Church. We will be limiting the number to 75 people, for the time being. We will also be celebrating Baptisms, weddings, 15eras, and funerals (not COVID related) in the church – again, limited number to 75 people. The Holy Hour following the evening Mass will be also be in the church – limited to 75 people. Music will remain as is: one cantor and one musician – both must wear masks. As per the protocols of the Archdiocese, temperatures will be taken, phone numbers recorded, social distancing and masks will be required. Windows and doors will be left open. Entrance to the church will be through the side door near the sacristy. People will exit through the front doors in the vestibule. Reservations will still be accepted. Sunday Masses still will be celebrated outside due to the large number of attendees.
