Dear Parishioner,

Peace be with you!

Following the lifting of the suspension of public celebrations of the sacrifice of Mass, St Teresa of Avila Church has opened its doors for the celebration of the Eucharist on Monday, June 8th, 2020. Our first weekend Mass is this coming weekend of June 13th and 14th, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi weekend. All of you are eager to return to celebrating the Eucharist as a community, and we must ensure that we are doing so safely and with great care for the well-being of all our community. We will continue to take all health precautions by following local health department guidelines for public gatherings and the Diocesan guidelines for the resumption of the public celebrations of Masses. Some of those safeguards, as you know, include: frequent sanitization of the church including pews and door handles; shared items such as hymnals will not be available; social distancing between those who do not share a household will be required; wearing masks during the entire liturgy; attendance at mass will be limited to 100 people; receiving communion in hands is required; hand sanitizers will be available and used during Mass, etc...

Due to the seating capacity limitation of 100 people, signs-ups will be required for each weekend Mass. We have set up a **reservation system** where you can sign up online and receive a confirmation. If you don't have internet access, please call the Parish Office to make your reservation. Please note: If you completed the parish survey, we thank you. The information helped us determine the need for a reservation system and overflow areas at some Masses. **Your response to the survey was not a reservation**, however. Please reserve your place using the link and instructions below:

Reservations can be made beginning this Wednesday morning for the Masses on June 13 and 14. This is only a reservation for those specific Masses. In the future, you can make reservations each week beginning on Monday mornings for the coming weekend Masses. Go to the SignupGenius website link at <https://www.stteresaauburn.com/mass-reservations>. Follow the simple instructions to select the Mass you want to attend that has space available for you and your family.

If you do not have internet access, please call the parish office at 530-889-2254. Ushers will have lists of the reservations for each Mass.

Those who are elderly and who have underlying health conditions or who are more vulnerable to the COVID-19 virus are strongly encouraged to remain home at this time and can follow the live-streamed Masses. We will maintain our normal Mass schedule on weekdays and weekends. Our 10:30 am Mass on Sundays will now be live-streamed and posted on Facebook and Youtube.

Thank you for your patience, and again, I would like to express my deep appreciation for all that you have done to help support our St Teresa of Avila Parish during these very challenging times. Let's continue to hold one another and our nation and the whole world in prayer. Stay safe.
