

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings in the Lord! All of us want to resume normal celebration of Sunday Masses in our church. However, Covid-19 is still with us and we are in the red tier (substantial risk). According to Government and Diocesan guidelines, our church can accommodate only 25% of its capacity or 125 people at this time. So, when you come to Sunday Mass please note that only 125 people can sit inside the church. Others please sit on the plaza (chairs will be provided). Ushers can guide you to be seated inside the church or on the plaza. If you like to make sure that you sit inside the church, please sign up early. We have a sign-up app (*Signup Genius*) on our webpage <https://stteresaauburn.com/>. Please sign up before 2:00 PM, Fridays. All your sign-up information will be kept strictly confidential. Hopefully, we will move to less restrictive tiers without much delay. The Bishop’s dispensation from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass during this pandemic is still in effect. Our Sunday Mass at 10.30 AM is livestreamed on our Facebook page and it may be watched anytime on our webpage.

In the days when Christ Jesus was in the flesh, he offered prayers and supplications with loud cries and tears to the one who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverence. Son though he was, he learned obedience from what he suffered; and when he was made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him.

Gospel:

Some Greeks who had come to worship at the Passover Feast came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and asked him, "Sir, we would like to see Jesus." Philip went and told Andrew; then Andrew and Philip went and told Jesus. Jesus answered them, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Amen, amen, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit. Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will preserve it for eternal life. Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there also will my servant be. The Father will honor whoever serves me.

"I am troubled now. Yet what should I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name." Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it and will glorify it again." The crowd there heard it and said it was thunder; but others said, "An angel has spoken to him." 
