From The Pastor's Desk

There's a war going on. Right now...right here. The war is inside each of us. It is a war between the old self and the new self. In some ways, it is a war for control; of our mind and our emotions. Our inner life is the battlefield. St Paul tells us: you should put away the old self of your former life...and put on the new self, created in God's way in righteousness and holiness of truth.

Say that you are sitting around with a group of friends, just having a good time and talking about different things. Then someone starts talking about a person that you all know. Soon everyone is talking about that person, making judgments and tearing that person's character apart. You feel uncomfortable because you can see what is going on there. They are really being unfair to this person who is not there to defend himself. And yet you say nothing. You remain silent because you are afraid of what your friends will think about you. At that point you are acting out of your old or false self. You are only doing what others want you to do, not what you know you should really do.

When we operate out of our old selves, we have lost contact with who we really are in God. The old self has no thoughts of its own. Whatever is fashionable in the culture is what he or she thinks. It's not hard to find whole groups of people who all think the same way about something, but when you question them as to the basis of their beliefs they do not know what to answer. They will give you a cliché for an answer because they haven't been able to really think deeply about the reasons for their actions. That precisely is one of the reasons that they feel most comfortable around people who think exactly as they do. They find comfort in the unthinking crowd.

The sign that we are living in the new self is integration. This means that no matter what we are doing or concerned about, the meaning of it all is based in our connection to the divine. Nothing in our life should be outside of the horizon of the Sacred. If we have to forget about God in order to do something, then we are not living in the new self. I do not mean that we have to consciously be thinking about God all of the time, but our connection to God must be the background for everything that we do in life.

Sacramental Preparation

On-site registration for Faith Formation sacramental preparation for the 2015/16 year takes place Sunday, August 9 and Sunday, August 16 after all the morning Masses in the dining room. Children registering for sacramental preparation must have completed one year of Faith Formation last year, whether it was at Holy Spirit or another parish. If it was at another parish, a Letter of Verification from that parish must be on file with our office prior to registering for sacramental preparation. Also, if you have a copy of the child's baptismal certificate, that would be awesome! Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in the 8th Grade or older and First Communion in the 2nd Grade. However, attendance for two consecutive years in Faith Formation/Youth Ministry remains a diocesan mandatory requirement for sacramental preparation. attendance when you register for sacramental preparation to ensure you meet the two-year requirement and that attendance was satisfactory the year prior. That means six absences or less during the 2014/15 Faith Formation year. You may contact Deborah, Devyn, Lindee or Lisa with any questions regarding sacramental preparation.

Information and paperwork regarding infant Baptism (ages 6 and under) may be directed to Lisa Estrada. Our next baptismal preparation class for parents and godparents is not until Saturday, September 12, from 9 am to 12:30 pm. All **completed** paperwork must be turned in no later than two weeks prior to the baptism class date.

- All families wishing to sign children up for Faith Formation must be registered members of Holy Spirit.
 If you haven't already completed a Parish Census Form to be a part of our wonderful faith community, you must do that first before picking up registration paperwork for Faith Formation.
- Children registering for sacramental preparation MUST HAVE completed one year of Faith Formation <u>last year</u>, whether it was at Holy Spirit or another parish. If it was at another parish, a Letter of Verification from that parish <u>MUST</u> be on file with our office prior to registering for sacramental preparation. Also, if you have a copy of the child's baptismal certificate, that would be awesome!
- ◆ The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in the 8th Grade or older and First Communion in the 2nd Grade. However, attendance for two consecutive years in Faith Formation/Youth Ministry remains a diocesan mandatory requirement for sacramental preparation. We check attendance when you register for sacramental preparation to ensure you meet the two-year requirement and that attendance was satisfactory the year prior. That means six absences or less for 2014/15.
- For paperwork received on the 9th or 16th, all Faith Formation registration fees/sacramental expenses must be paid in full by Thursday, August 20 before your child will be placed on a class roster. Current class fees are \$45.00 for one child; \$90.00 for two children; and \$105.00 for three or more children. Sacramental expenses are separate. Class fees will increase again as of August 28 so register now!

SPECIAL NOTE: We will not accept registrations after Thursday, August 20 in order to prepare for the first day of class and Parent Orientation on Sunday, August 30. You can still obtain paperwork Monday through Thursday, 10 am to 4 pm but it will not be processed until after the Labor Day Holiday. Children registering after August 20 will attend class on September 7. And absolutely no registration paperwork will be processed on Sunday, August 30!!

Classes are already filling up so don't delay in registering your children for next year's Faith Formation, especially children in 1st Grade, as this is the required first year of First Communion preparation or if last year was your child's first year of the two-year sacramental requirement. If you received a fee statement in the mail, those are now due in order for your child to be placed on a class roster for the upcoming year. We cannot guarantee class availability for those with outstanding balances. Please contact Deborah with any questions. All outstanding fees must be paid in full by August 20. 
