Planned Giving Brief - CARES Act updates:

1. This recently passed Congressional law includes a new deduction for charitable donors who do not itemize when filing their tax returns. You will be allowed to take a special tax deduction, up to \$300, to reduce your tax liability.
2. The recently passed Congressional law includes an increase in a tax deduction limit up to 100% of a donor’s annual income for cash gifts. Make a gift to the parish this year and deduct more when you prepare your 2020 tax return.
3. If you are concerned about your financial security given the ups and downs of the stock market during the COVID-19 crisis, you may want to consider funding a charitable gift annuity and at the same time make a gift to our parish. Provide for your family, protect your assets, and give at the same time.
