Every Kansas State Representative and State Senator office will be on the ballot in 2020.

In order to participate in the upcoming August 4th Kansas State Primary Election, citizens must be registered to vote by July 14th. Please stop in (location) where volunteers are available to help you register. Or visit www.kansascatholic.org to register on your own.

It is important to register especially if you recently turned 18, recently moved or had a name change, have not voted in recent elections, or if you are unsure if you have registered in the past. Registering to vote ensures that you are able to vote and that you are voting at the correct polling location.
