CONFESSIONS

Until further notice and in compliance with social distancing regulations, Confessions will be IN THE RECTORY OFFICE on Saturdays from 4:00 - 4:30 PM.

NOTICE: The new procedures for communion will be:

-Just one line for communion (as we have done previously) BUT, there will be ONE eucharistic minister plus Father Dan distributing communion. They both will be 6 feet apart from each other.

- Use hand sanitizer AND KEEP yourr mask in place while receiving communion.

-We ask that you take two steps aside before consuming communion. (take mask off, consume the Body of Christ, and then put mask back on).

-We will still cover the ciboriums (bowls with the Body of Christ) with Corporals.

-The Extraordinary Eucharistic Minister MUST use a mask (if someone refuses to use it, we will need to ask a different person to do that service). -The Eucharistic minister won't need to use a Faceshield.

-IF, for some reason someone in the crowd is not wearing a mask they can come and receive communion with me (I will be using my Faceshield).
