Until further notice and in compliance with social distancing regulations, Confessions will be IN THE RECTORY OFFICE on Saturdays from 4:00 - 4:30 PM.

NOTICE: The procedures for communion will be:

-Just one line for communion (as we have done previously). - Use hand sanitizer AND KEEP your mask in place while receiving communion. We ask that you take two steps to the side before consuming communion. (take mask off, consume the Body of Christ, and then put mask back on). We will still cover the ciboriums (bowls with the Body of Christ) with Corporals. Again, **MASKS ARE REQUIRED** to attend Mass.
