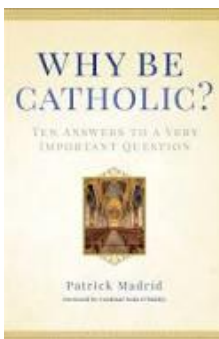
RCIA Classes Forming Now!

Madrid Speaking Event for Saturday, August 28th at the Anderson Building. We will also have a special "Celebration Family Weekend" that entire weekend with some special surprises to be announced soon.



We are excited to give you an update about our combined Campaign ***One Faith, One Family, One Future in Christ*** which was scheduled to conclude last December. **We are excited because we have recently satisfied the Archdiocesan portion of the campaign!** As a result, all future contributions that are received will be returned in full to our parish for our building campaign.

Our updated numbers are as follows:

58 donors - 31% participation rate

Total campaign goal (building project cost + archdiocesan goal)	\$790,000.00
Contribution from parish savings	<u>\$290,000.00</u>
Fundraising goal	\$500,000.00
Total pledges to date	-\$264,969.23
Donations from non-parishioners	- <u>\$225,000.00</u>
Amount of new pledges and donations needed to meet original goal	<u>\$ 10,030.77</u>

Unfortunately, one of the side effects of the pandemic is much higher building material costs. In the last year, many material costs have risen as much as 30%. Therefore, we anticipate that **we will need to exceed our original goal in order to complete the project.**

Next Sunday, May 9th, we will hold a town hall meeting after mass at the Knights Hall to provide more details and an opportunity for questions regarding the campaign. Please join us for a complimentary biscuits and gravy breakfast provided by the Knights of Columbus and learn more about the progress on our capital campaign. If you are unable to attend, a second town hall meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 12th at 7:00 p.m. at the Knights Hall.
