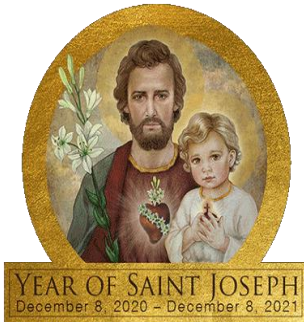

## The Year of St. Joseph, A Year of Virtues



The four Cardinal Virtues are Prudence, Justice, Temperance, and Fortitude. The last three virtues are grouped around Prudence. Prudence is the virtue of prayerful discernment. It is a personal virtue and leads each person to their own best options in decision making for their lives. The definition of discernment is the perception in the absence of judgement with a view of obtaining spiritual direction and understanding.

In order to be prudent, we need to conform our conscience to the guidance of the teachings of the Catholic faith. This will help us discern what is good and right for ourselves. Just as food is good for the body, living a virtuous life is good food for the soul.

This virtue of Prudence takes a lifetime to grow and perfect. When struggling with spiritual direction and understanding, it can be helpful to seek counsel of those whose wisdom is greater than your own.
