The Year of St. Joseph, A Year of Virtues

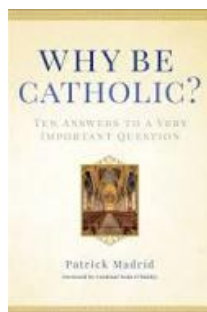


YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH

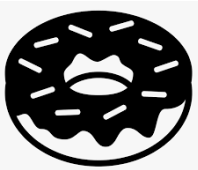
