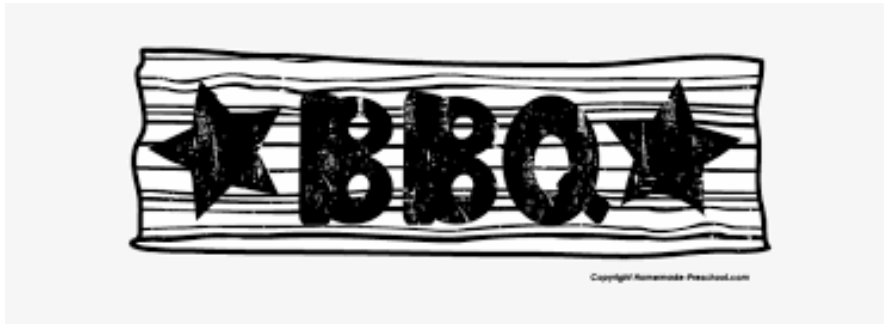

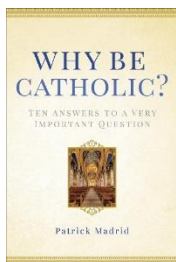
The event will again be held at Hoelting’s Grove (Knights Hall in case of rain) and tickets will be limited, so get yours early!

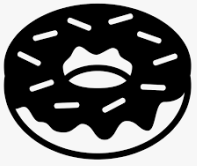

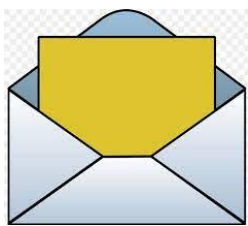


Celebration for Father's Day
