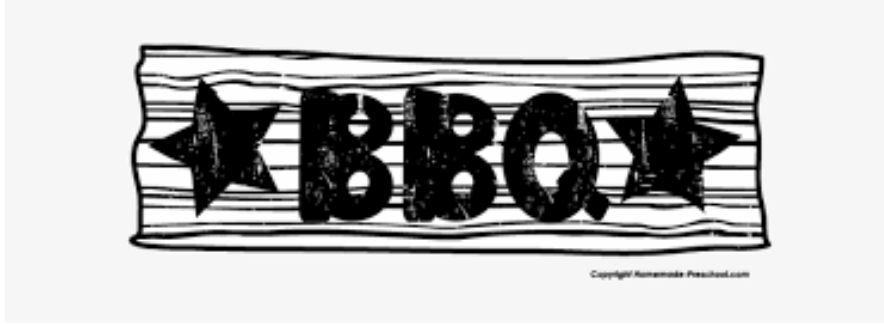

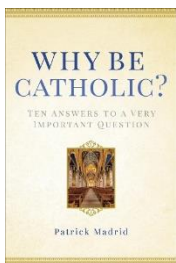
The event will again be held at Hoelting’s Grove (Knights Hall in case of rain) and tickets will be limited, so get yours early!

Third grade through twelfth grade students of religious education are put on a rotating serving list throughout each year. Due to Covid 19, we discontinued doing that. Weekend servers have been a part of the liturgy for many weeks now. Father Dan would like to have morning mass servers again.

As in the past, this has been a great way for the 4th graders and others to practice before being added to the weekend list. Morning servers will be listed in the bulletin starting July 1st and 2nd until the completion of the first week of August. They are asked to arrive 10 minutes before mass at 7:30am. Fourth grade students will be added each May and twelfth grade students will be taken off the list.

It is important for all families to know that it is their responsibility to find a replacement for their part in the liturgy if they are unable to be at mass when they are scheduled. This can be done by switching days or months.

Father Dan would also like for families to begin bringing up the gifts for the weekend masses.

There isn't a list to schedule from so starting August 7th & 8th, the Bringing of the Gifts will be done by the server's family according to when the children are scheduled to serve. Hopefully, this will work for everyone.
