Who is Patrick Madrid?

Best-selling author and radio host Patrick Madrid will be hosted by St. Joseph Parish at the Anderson Building on August 28th to present a seminar on the biblical and historical foundations of the Catholic Faith. The seminar, entitled "Why Be Catholic?," is an informative presentation aimed at showing how the Bible, current events, and the facts of Christian history can answer common questions and challenges to the Catholic Church, its teachings, and practices. Our event will begin with continental breakfast and registration at 8:00 and the talks will begin at 9:00 and end at 4:00. We will then invite all to come to 5:00 Mass here at St. Joseph Church.

After an intermission for refreshments and a book signing by Mr. Madrid, who will have many of his books, DVDs, and CDs available, a lively question-and-answer session with extended audience participation will follow his morning and afternoon talks.

Patrick Madrid has authored or edited 23 books on Catholic themes including, Why Be Catholic?, Pope Fiction, Search and Rescue, Does the Bible Really Say That?, The Godless Delusion, and the multi-volume Surprised by Truth series.

Mr. Madrid earned a B.S. in business management, as well as a B.Phil. in philosophy and an M.A. in theology at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio. He and his wife Nancy have been married for 34 years and have eleven children and 17 grandchildren. In addition to his work as an author, Madrid also hosts the popular morning "Patrick Madrid" show on the Relevant Radio Network (www.relevantradio.com/patrick or Relevant radio app), heard Monday through Friday from 8-11 a.m. Central in over 160 radio stations nationwide.

At the invitation of numerous bishops and priests, Patrick has conducted hundreds of apologetics and evangelization conferences in English and Spanish at parishes, seminaries, and universities across the U.S., as well as throughout Europe, Asia, and Latin America. He is a regular presenter at Franciscan University of Steubenville's "Defending the Faith" summer conferences, where he has served as an adjunct professor of theology. He is also an adjunct professor in the graduate theology program at Holy Apostles College and Seminary in Cromwell, CT. Cardinal Edward Egan, the former Archbishop of New York, commented on Mr. Madrid's unique and effective approach to Catholic apologetics and evangelization saying, "How do you bring a friend or relative back into the Church? First you pray. Then, you follow Patrick Madrid's advice in his book Search and Rescue."
