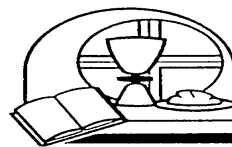

Saint of the Week: April 17(Canada)- St. Kateri Tekakwitha (1657-1680) was the first North American indigenous woman to be canonized. She was born on the southern bank of the Mohawk River at Osserneon. When she was four years old, a smallpox epidemic killed her parents and brother and left her with seriously impaired eyesight and a disfigured face. Hearing about Christ from Jesuit missionaries, she chose to be a Christian, was baptized on Easter Sunday 1676 and assumed the name Kateri, a Mohawk form of Catherine, likely in honour of St. Catherine of Siena. To avoid persecution, she traveled to a Christian native community south of Montreal. She had a strong devotion to the Eucharist, was faithful to prayer, cared for children and had a deep concern for others. She died on April 17, 1680 and was canonized in 2012.
