## From Fr. Robert...

To those of you back at church this weekend, welcome back! I've missed you! To those who have chosen to stay home, I respect your caution - and you can feel free to do so for as long as the Bishop continues to give us all a dispensation from our Sunday Obligation. I'm glad we have the technology to continue live-streaming Mass too. Today we celebrate Trinity Sunday, when we meditate on the central mystery of our faith, God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Unity is an essential property of God, who is three persons in one God. We could say that God is unity. God desires to unite us as well - both to unite us to Himself and to unite us to one another in the one Body of Christ. Jesus expresses this desire of God's heart as he prays to the Father in John 17: "And I have given them the glory you gave me, so that they may be one, as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may be brought to perfection as one, that the world may know that you sent me, and that you loved them even as you loved me." As we slowly come back to Mass, I think it is important to recognize how this delights God's heart - that we be united together as one - that we come together as the Body of Christ in worship of God. The more we unite together in one mind and heart with our eyes fixed on God, the more we become united to the God who is one communion of love - the Father, who lives and reigns with the Son in the *unity* of the Holy Spirit, one God forever and ever.

Para aquellos de ustedes que regresaron a la iglesia este fin de semana, ¡bienvenidos de nuevo! ¡Les he extrañado! Para aquellos que han optado por quedarse en casa, respeto su precaución. Mientras que el Obispo continúe dándonos una dispensa de nuestra obligación dominical, todos tenemos la opción de quedarnos en casa. Me alegra que también tengamos la tecnología para continuar la transmisión en vivo de la Misa. Hoy celebramos el Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad, cuando meditamos sobre el misterio central de nuestra fe, Dios, que es Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. La unidad es una propiedad esencial de Dios, que es tres personas en un solo Dios. Podríamos decir que Dios *es* la unidad. Dios desea unarnos también, tanto para unarnos a Sí mismo como para unarnos unos con otros en el único Cuerpo de Cristo. Jesús expresa este deseo del corazón de Dios mientras ora al Padre en el evangelio según San Juan, cap. 17: "Yo les he dado la gloria que Tú me diste, para que sean uno como nosotros somos uno. Yo en ellos y Tú en mí, para que sean consumados en la unidad, y conozca el mundo que Tú me has enviado y los has amado como me amaste a mí." A medida que regresamos lentamente a la Misa, creo que es importante reconocer cómo esto alegra el corazón de Dios, que estemos unidos en uno, que nos unamos como el Cuerpo de Cristo en la adoración de Dios. Cuanto más nos unimos en una sola mente y corazón con nuestros ojos fijos en Dios, más nos unimos al Dios que es una comunión de amor: el Padre, que vive y reina con el Hijo en la unidad del Espíritu Santo y es Dios por los siglos de los siglos.

### Guidelines for Mass

1. A mask or another face covering will be required of everyone over 2 years of age who attends Mass. Masks will be available for those who do not bring their own.
2. Households (those who live under the same roof) must sit 6 feet apart. The pews are marked with a blue "X" where households are asked to sit. "X marks the spot."
3. Communion is to be received in the hand only. However, if one has strong preference for receiving on the tongue, I am happy to honor that, but Communion must be distributed to these individuals after Mass. It would be helpful to let me know before Mass that you would like to take advantage of this option.
4. No one may congregate in the church, by the entryway, or in the parish hall before or after Mass. Coffee and rolls cannot resume yet.
5. You may be asked to sit in the overflow area in the basement if all the seating in the church has been occupied. This seems to me a better alternative to assigning people to come to a specific Mass and sit in a specific seat. If it is apparent that more people desire to come to mass than there are seats available, we may move at least one weekend Mass outdoors or add a weekend Mass.



First Holy Communion will be Sunday, June 28<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 am. Mass. There will be a retreat for the communicants Saturday, June 27 from 8:30am-Noon. Please keep the communicants in your prayers as they continue their sacramental preparation.



In celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, June 19 there will be a holy hour from 5-6pm followed by mass at 6:00 p.m.
