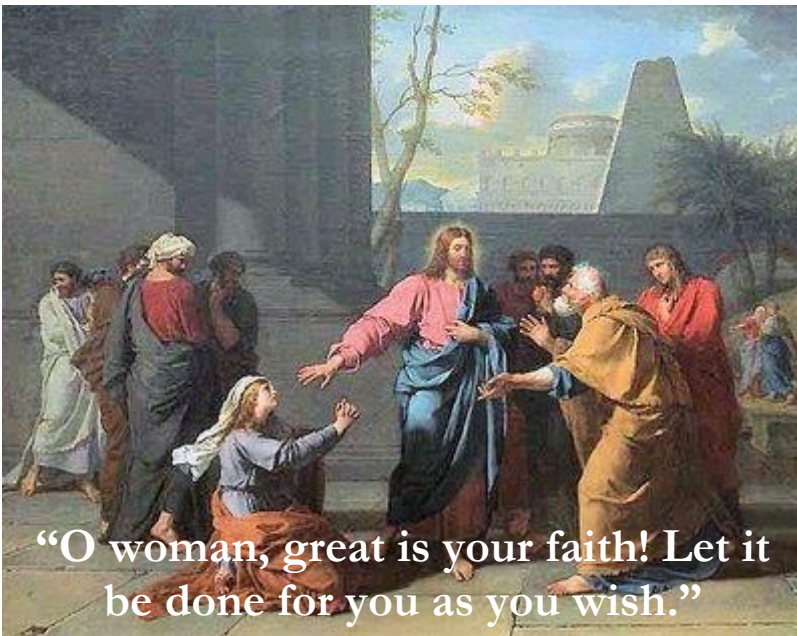

From Fr. Robert...

As school gets back in session soon, let's remember teachers, students, and parents in our prayers in a special way. It is an uncertain and stressful time for many in our community. We pray, dear Lord, for health and safety for all in our community, but, especially for peace of heart and that everyone might turn to you in their need, trusting in your goodness that you will provide and guide. On that note, just a reminder that we all must prioritize our prayer life, especially these days, or we will lose our way and easily fall into despair or cynicism or anger one of many other spiritual pitfalls that separate us from God. Prayer should provide 1) the perspective and 2) the inspiration for us to get throughout our day. For most of us (there are some "strange" exceptions), if we skip breakfast we become "hangry" by midmorning -- we lose our energy and get cranky. Yet, it would make more sense to skip breakfast than to skip morning prayer, because our spiritual lives are even more important than our physical well being. When we really tap into the power of the Holy Spirit, we become sources of light, love, peace, and joy to all we encounter. What a gift we have the power to give people every day! But it takes intentional prayer, because we can't do it by ourselves! Mother Mary, we celebrate your Queenship this Saturday. Hail Holy Queen...! Help us, your children, to never lose sight of your Son, Jesus, and to never lose the fire of love which is His Holy Spirit alive in each of our hearts. Amen!

A medida que la escuela vuelva a estar en sesión pronto, recordemos a los maestros, estudiantes y padres en nuestras oraciones de una manera especial. Es un momento incierto y estresante para muchos en nuestra comunidad. Oramos, querido Señor, por la salud y la seguridad de todos en nuestra comunidad, pero, especialmente, por la paz del corazón y para que todos puedan acudir a ti en su necesidad, confiando en tu bondad que tú brindarás y guiarás. En esa nota, solo un recordatorio de que todos debemos priorizar nuestra vida de oración, especialmente en estos días, o perderemos nuestro camino y caeremos fácilmente en la desesperación, el cinismo o la ira, una de las muchas otras trampas espirituales que nos separan de Dios. La oración debe proporcionar 1) la perspectiva y 2) la inspiración para que pasemos bien a lo largo de nuestro día. Para la mayoría de nosotros (hay algunas excepciones "extrañas"), si no comemos el desayuno, nos sentimos "hambrientos" a media mañana, perdemos la energía y nos ponemos de mal humor. Sin embargo, tendría más sentido omitir el desayuno que omitir la oración de la mañana, porque nuestra vida espiritual es, tanto más importante que nuestro bienestar físico. Cuando realmente aprovechamos el poder del Espíritu Santo, nos convertimos en fuentes de luz, amor, paz y gozo para todos los que encontramos. ¡Qué regalo tenemos el poder de dar a la gente todos los días! Pero se necesita oración intencional, ¡porque no podemos hacerlo solos! Madre María, este sábado celebramos su reinado. ¡Hail Santa, Reina ...! Ayúdanos, tus hijos, a no perder nunca de vista a tu Hijo, Jesús, y no perder nunca el fuego del amor que es Su Espíritu Santo vivo en cada uno de nuestros corazones. ¡Amén!
