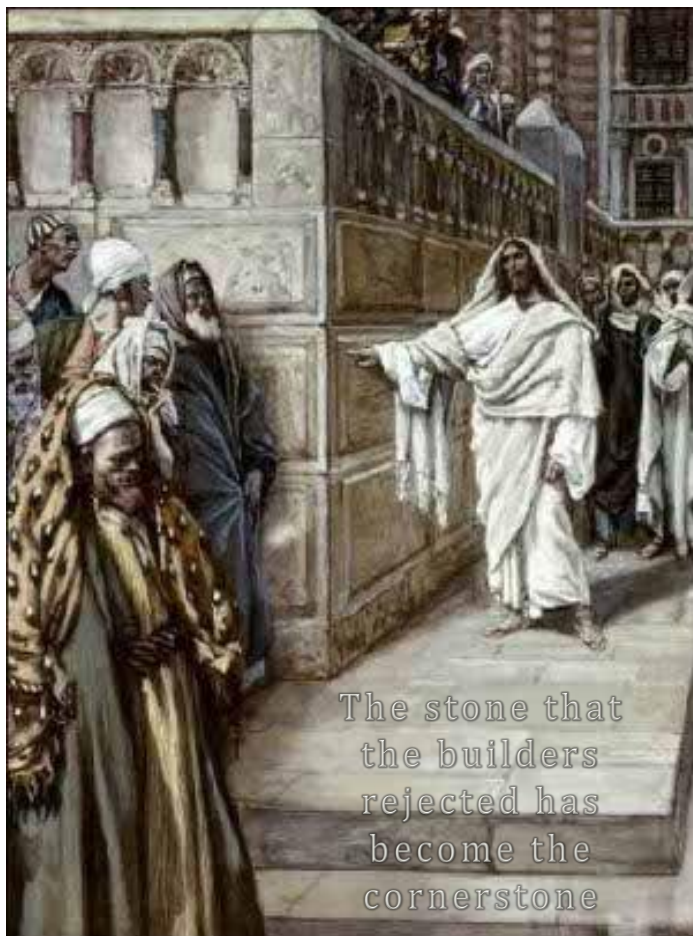

From Fr. Robert. . .

October is the Month of the Rosary! It's easier for me to remember that because my Dad's birthday was on the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, **October 7th**. The Rosary is, of course, the most popular devotional prayer in the Catholic Church. All of us have at least one Rosary (probably more) somewhere - in our pocket, on our rearview mirror, in our dresser drawer... Much more difficult than having a rosary is *praying* the Rosary. I'm not sure why that is... maybe because it seems boring and repetitious. The reality is that it is a great weapon in our hand which is instrumental in bringing about peace - peace in our hearts, peace in our families, and peace in our world. I'm not over exaggerating! One of the main messages of Our Lady of Fatima was simply to pray the Rosary daily for peace. This request of our Heavenly Mother should be enough to motivate us to at least attempt to pray it! I've experienced first hand the power of the Holy Rosary. The family rosary, prayed daily, can transform a family - or at least keep it firmly rooted in the love of Jesus. That's because the Rosary gives us an opportunity to offer 15-20 minutes of our lives back to Jesus with our hearts and minds occupied with His life and love through the mysteries we contemplate. My goal for this October is to try to be less distracted while praying my daily Rosary. My means to accomplish this will be to say a little prayer before the Rosary that I might give myself whole-heartedly to the prayer. I'm also going to intentionally imagine myself in the scenes of the mysteries I'm praying more often. Our world is in such need of the Peace of Jesus Christ. Will you join me in praying the Rosary every day during the month of October?

¡Octubre es el Mes del Rosario! Es más fácil para mí recordar eso porque el cumpleaños de mi papá fue en la fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Rosario, el 7 de octubre. El Rosario es, por supuesto, la oración devocional más popular en la Iglesia Católica. Todos tenemos por lo menos un Rosario (probablemente más) en algún lugar: en nuestro bolsillo, en nuestro espejo retrovisor, en el cajón de nuestra cómoda ... Mucho más difícil que tener un rosario es rezar el Rosario. No estoy seguro de por qué es eso ... tal vez porque parece aburrido y repetitivo. La realidad es que es una gran arma en nuestras manos que es fundamental para lograr la paz: paz en nuestros corazones, paz en nuestras familias y paz en nuestro mundo. ¡No estoy exagerando demasiado! Uno de los principales mensajes de Nuestra Señora de Fátima fue simplemente rezar el Rosario diariamente por la paz. ¡Esta petición de nuestra Madre Celestial debería ser suficiente para motivarnos al menos a intentar rezarla! He experimentado de primera mano el poder del Santo Rosario. El rosario familiar, rezado a diario, puede transformar una familia, o al menos mantenerla firmemente arraigada en el amor de Jesús. Eso es porque el Rosario nos da la oportunidad de ofrecer de 15 a 20 minutos de nuestras vidas a Jesús con nuestros corazones y mentes ocupados con Su vida y amor por los misterios que contemplamos. Mi objetivo para este mes de octubre es tratar de estar menos distraído mientras rezo mi Rosario diario. Mi medio para lograr esto será decir una pequeña oración antes del Rosario para poder entregarme de todo corazón a la oración. También me voy a imaginar intencionalmente en las escenas de los misterios que estoy rezando con más frecuencia. Nuestro mundo tiene tanta necesidad de la Paz de Jesucristo. ¿Te unirás a mí para rezar el Rosario todos los días durante el mes de octubre?
