

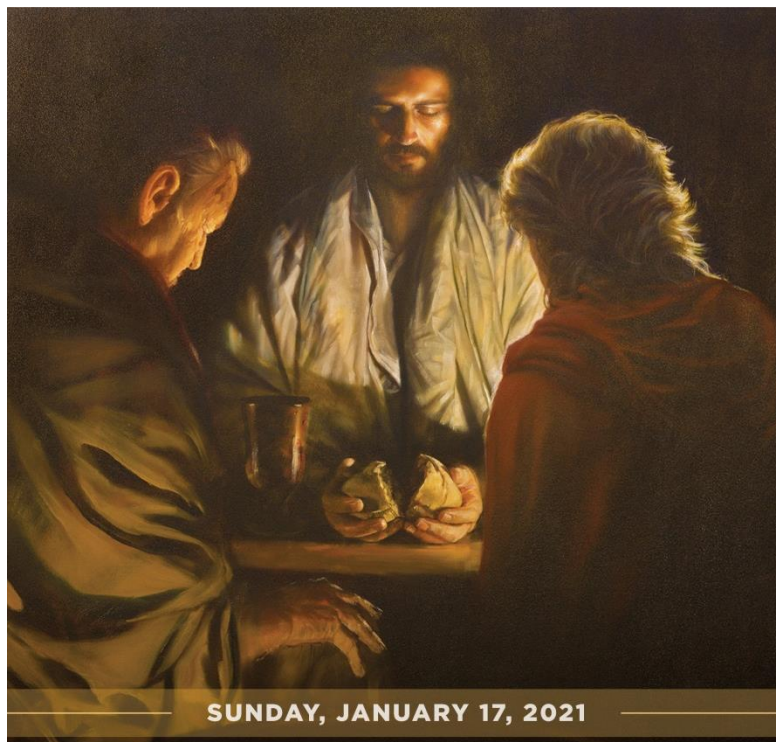

From Fr. Robert. . .

My dear brothers and sisters, let us continue to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus! Let us seek to know Him better and better by encountering Him in His Word and taking time daily to pray to Him -- sincerely and from the heart. His constant love for us is beyond our imagining! This Friday is the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children". It would be a great act of love to unite our prayers and sacrifices that day with Catholics across the country to fervently beg God for this grace. This is a matter of ethics, values, and faith at the most important level. No matter who is in Washington, we as Catholics have a duty to continue to foster the Culture of Life. Only when hearts change will definitive progress be made -- and that starts with our own hearts and on the level of family and community. We must never fail to proclaim that all life is sacred and inviolable -- from the very moment of conception till natural death. We must also help foster a Culture of Life by seeing children as a blessing and a gift from God and by helping people in difficult situations (single mothers, young mothers, financially-struggling mothers) to know they are loved and supported and have options to choose life. The Serenity Pregnancy Resource Center and other similar initiatives are a great example of the loving support that is available to women in difficult situations. There is also healing available for women who have had abortions, for instance through the Rachel's Vineyard ministry. As we come to know and love Jesus more and more, the beauty of life takes on an ever richer dimension, as He Himself is the "Way, the Truth, and the Life."

También debemos ayudar a fomentar una cultura de vida viendo a los niños como una bendición y un regalo de Dios y ayudando a las personas en situaciones difíciles (madres solteras, madres jóvenes, madres con dificultades económicas) a saber que son amados y apoyados y que tienen opciones para elegir la vida. El Centro Serenity, un centro de Recursos para el Embarazo y otras iniciativas similares son un gran ejemplo del apoyo amoroso que está disponible para las mujeres en situaciones difíciles. También hay curación disponible para mujeres que han tenido abortos, por ejemplo, a través del ministerio Rachel's Vineyard. A medida que conocemos y amamos a Jesús cada vez más, la belleza de la vida adquiere una dimensión cada vez más rica, ya que Él mismo es el "Camino, la Verdad y la Vida".
