

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Kevin,

I continue to pray that you and your loved ones are healthy and have the resources you need amidst the current restrictions. We are going into two weeks if not more and we know these measures are designed to protect our wellbeing and that of our broader community and world. As a Christian family of faith, this is also a time to consider our need for spiritual unity and the needs of our brothers and sisters in Christ.

The fact that this pandemic is occurring during our Lenten journey it offers each of us important reminders about the role of faith, hope and charity in our daily lives and in whom we place our trust. I believe we are being called by Jesus Christ to a renewed sense of solidarity. This is a time for unity in prayer, not for isolation; it is a time for hope, not despair; it is a time for generosity, not self-focus. Ismael Sandoval-Manzo at 10 a.m. I still continue to offer masses privately, for the intentions that we have as well as St. Kevin Parish.

I want to thank those that have sent their collection envelope to St. Kevin . Cancellation of Masses is leading to significant loss in our offertory income. To your discretion, if you would like to mail your offertory envelope please mail it or drop it off in the mailbox. Our dinner dance ad book will still take place, if you would like to support us please mail in your ad form.

We are in the works of building up the website for St. Kevin; also like our page on facebook (@stkevinchurch) as we try to provide resources from the archdiocese or neighboring parishes to help us all remain close to Jesus during this time of distress and peril.


