"This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe they were recently exposed to Covid-19 or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital or a nursing facility; those who care for the sick, the infirm, and the homebound; those who are unable to attend Mass through no fault of their own; those with underlying conditions or in a high-risk category; and those who have significant fear or anxiety of becoming ill by attending Mass."

We Need Heroic Catholics to Restore Sanity in the World

(We Have the Truth and the Sacraments)



The *genius* of Satan is to deceive the human **mind** in order to seduce the human **will**. Satan knows that all the evil in the world begins with error. In other words, all sin in the human heart **begins** as untruth in the human mind.

It is nothing less than producing saints among Christians in every state of life. **Ordinary** bishops, ordinary priests, ordinary religious, ordinary fathers and mothers, ordinary Catholics will not even survive the massive revolution through which the Church is going in our day. We need **heroic** Catholics, sanctified by the Holy Spirit, to restore even **sanity** in the modern world.

That is why the Pope John Paul II dedicated the second last year of our *century* to the Holy Spirit. By His divine **power**, where sin has abounded, there grace will even more abound, *beyond* all human expectations. There is only one proviso. We must cooperate with this grace for the redemption of the modern **world**.
