The Feast of Epiphany celebrates three manifestations of God, among them is the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan where Jesus is revealed as the Son of God, the second person of the Holy Trinity and in which event Our Lord sanctifies the water by His baptism for our own baptism.

For this reason, on the vigil of the Feast of the Epiphany, the Church gives us a particularly powerful blessing of water. We invite you to a Special Solemn Vespers at 6:00 PM on January 5th, to be followed by the blessing of Epiphany water.
