There will be a simple blessing of candles at the 6:15 AM, 8:00 AM, and 6:00 PM Masses, with the Solemn Blessing happening at the 7:30 High Mass. You are welcome to bring candles from home to be blessed and we will also have 12" beeswax tapers available for a \$2.00 donation.

Candles may be dropped off in the Church on Tuesday and should be picked up no later than Wednesday.
