Youth Walking Pilgrimage to the National Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe

Young Men: June 7 - 12, 2021 | Young Women: June 14 - 19, 2021

Join us on a 5-day hike along the famous Elroy-Sparta & La Crosse River Trails across the rolling hills of Wisconsin's interior to the beautiful National Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. We'll camp in tents for 4 nights & stay the last night at a hotel.

Monday: Arrive at St. Jerome Catholic Church, Wonewoc, WI at 12:00 pm
We will have an Organizational and safety meeting before heading out.

Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday: Every day begins with Mass at our Campsite. Then after breakfast, we prepare our lunch for the day and pack our things into our carrying bags and the van, and together begin the next leg of the trail. Once we reach the day's destination, we will set up the campsite and have dinner, relax, and enjoy the evening!

Friday: We arrive in the afternoon at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. We will celebrate our final Mass here and stay at a hotel in La Crosse.

Saturday: Parent pick up by 11:00 AM in La Crosse.

The cost of the trip is \$150, and includes food, camping fees, and hotel. Permission slips and checks made payable to St. John Cantius, must be returned to St. Peter's no later than Wednesday, June 2nd, or sent directly to St. John Cantius by June 5th.

This walking pilgrimage is a continuous five-day, four-night event for youth, ages 13 - 20, and is conducted by two religious as well as other adult chaperones.

Congratulations to Deacon Joseph Brom, SJC, who was ordained to the Diaconate on May 8th by Cardinal Blase Cupich at Holy Name Cathedral in Chicago.

Deacon Joseph's first Masses as a Deacon, are this Sunday, May 9th, at St. Peter's. Deacon Joseph will offer the homily at the 8:30 AM, 10:00 AM, and 11:30 AM Masses. Join us immediately following all three of these Masses over in the School for a small reception and the opportunity to congratulate Deacon Joseph in person!

Deacon Joseph grew up in Lisle, Illinois, and is the son of Richard and Peg Brom. He attended Bennet Academy before studying at the University of Illinois in Champaign. He later received a Ph.D. in Materials Science and Engineering from Penn State University.



Deacon Joseph will minister here at St. Peter's in Volo, while concluding his final year at Mundelein Seminary in preparation for his Ordination to the Priesthood in the Spring of 2022. He is also beginning studies in Canon Law at the Catholic University of America this summer.
