Have you heard about the devotion of reparation to the Holy Face of Jesus? It is a devotion that was first heard of through a Carmelite Nun named Sister Mary of St. Peter in 1844. Sister Mary of St. Peter stated that Our Lord revealed this devotion to her at Mount Carmel, and that Our Lord wanted this devotion to be spread throughout the world with the goal of making reparation for the sins which offend God.

Beginning Thursday, September 2nd, we invite you to join us at 7:00 PM for a Holy Hour of Reparation to the Holy Face of Jesus. The holy hour will be held on the first Thursday of each month, and will include veneration of a Vatican verified Holy Face relic, Eucharistic Adoration, rosary, and prayers.
