Church Restoration & Repairs

We have been working diligently on the repairs to the church in an effort to return her to her full beauty. Having completed the window repairs, façade tuckpointing, and roof improvements, we have turned our attentions to the necessary restoration of the church interior. Over the coming weeks the repair of the damaged plaster will take place, with crews on site working Monday-Friday. As you can see, this work will require extensive scaffolding, and we ask you to please be aware of the scaffolding at all times.

As previously announced, some of the repairs will be covered by insurance and some by the funds that many generously gave through the *To Teach Who Christ Is* campaign. Earlier this year we began our capital campaign to *Restore St. Peter’s*, and all donations given to this campaign will continue to go to restoring the church. If you wish to give to the fund, please be sure to write “*Restoration*” in the memo line of your donation.

We have completed a lot in the last 12-months, however there is still quite a bit of work to be done. In addition to the plaster repairs, we are also currently working to expand the sound system inside the church, restore the church doors, and more. Please see to the right for a breakdown of upcoming restoration and repair costs, as well as expenditures to date. And as always, thank you for your continued support and generosity.
