Please check the altar servers' robes and Father's white robe. If they need washing please tell Susan Shirek. Altar linens in need of cleaning should be placed in mesh bag in sacristy closet. Altar linens must be dry cleaned if soiled. Altar Society will be reimbursed for the bill for dry cleaning. Clean the vathroom and check the toilet paper, kleenx and paper towels.

IMPORTANT: Cleaners are responsible for changing the alta cloths/banners to match the Liturgical colors for each mass. The colors are listed on the Catholic calendar in the sacristy. Cleaners for the weeks of Advent must out out the Advent wreath and greenery around it. Therr can be no decorations in front of or behind the altar during Advent. Christman decorations must be taken down after the baptism of the Lord.
