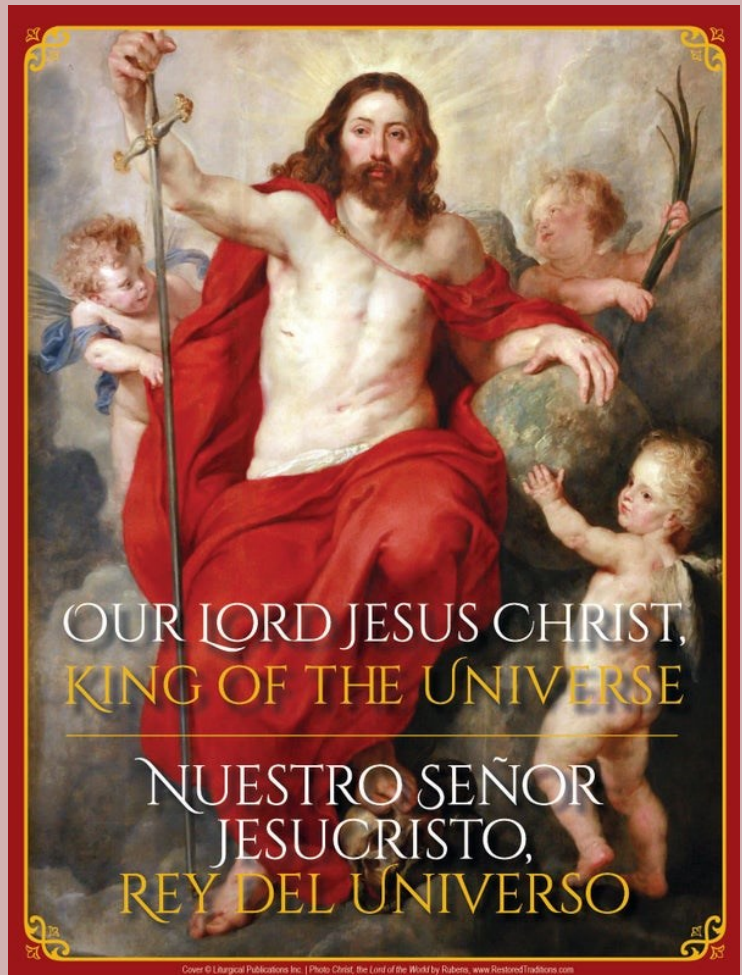

365 Days for Life Sacramento

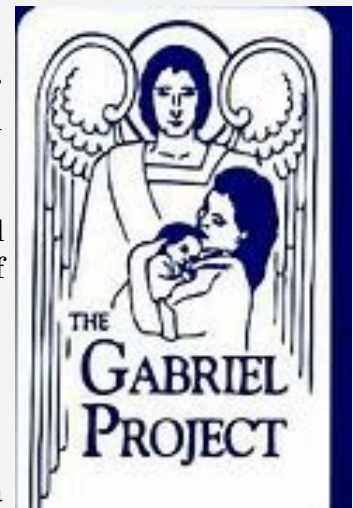
During this Fall 40 Days for Life, we have now learned that at least 588 lives have been saved from abortion, including seven babies in Sacramento, where parishioners from throughout the area prayed daily outside Planned Parenthood. One young mom in particular, homeless and nine weeks pregnant, was headed in to have an abortion, but changed her mind because she was offered the help she needed. Even though the Fall 40 Days has ended, Sacramento is a 365 Days for Life City and prayers and offers of help will continue at this abortion clinic. Durante este otoño de 40 días por la vida, ahora nos enteramos de que al menos 588 vidas se han salvado del aborto, incluidos siete bebés en Sacramento, donde los feligreses de toda el área oraban diariamente fuera de Planned Parenthood. Una madre joven en particular, sin hogar y con nueve semanas de embarazo, iba a tener un aborto, pero cambió de opinión porque le ofrecieron la ayuda que necesitaba. A pesar de que los 40 días de otoño han terminado, Sacramento es una ciudad de 365 días por la vida y las oraciones y ofertas de ayuda continuarán en esta clínica de abortos.
