Please read about the [guidelines](#) and [precautions](#) that we will be following, including the expectation to wear masks in the church, to sanitize hands before and after entering the church and before and after receiving Holy Communion, and remaining 6 ft apart at all times, even in the Holy Communion line. For those living in the same household, the 6 ft distancing requirement does not apply; they simply need to remain 6 ft away from others. Until further notice, the ministries of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and altar boys will be suspended. We will also not be passing a basket for collection for fear of spreading the virus, so we will have collection sites marked as you exit the church, or donations can be mailed in, left at the office or submitted via [Faith Direct](#). For those remaining at home, we will continue to live-stream Masses each day. Please prayerfully consider whether or not to attend, especially if you are vulnerable to COVID19 and its symptoms. If you or someone in your home is suffering from flu-like symptoms, please remain home for your sake and the sake of your fellow parishioners. We will do our best to prevent the chance of spreading viruses, but we will never be able to eliminate all risk.
