

# BASIC CATHOLIC QUESTIONS: Kindergarten 2020-2021

## 1<sup>st</sup> Semester

K.1 *How many Gods do we believe in?* We believe in One God.

K.2 *What is the mystery of the Blessed Trinity?* God is Three Divine Persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. This mystery is called the Blessed Trinity or Holy Trinity.

K.3 *Who is the Creator of Heaven and Earth?* God the Father is the Creator of Heaven and Earth and everything in it.

K.4 *Where do all good things come from?* All good things are gifts from God.

K.5 *What is one way we know God is the Creator?* We know God is the Creator through the beauty and order of nature.

K.6 *What are ways we can experience God's love?* We can experience God's love through the love of others, such as family and friends.

K.7 *Does God love each of us?* Yes, God loves each of us very much and wants us to be happy with Him forever in Heaven.

K.8 *Does God love us more than anyone else can love us?* Yes, God loves us more than anyone else can love us.

K.9 *Why are we special to God?* Each person is special to God because He made us in His image.

K.10 *What special gift does God give each of us to help us get to heaven?* God gives each of us a guardian angel who helps us get to Heaven.

K.11 *Is the Bible the word of God?* Yes, the Bible is the Word of God.

K.12 *Who is Jesus?* Jesus is the Son of God.

K.13 *Who is Mary?* Mary is the Mother of God.

K.14 *Who is Joseph?* Joseph is Jesus' foster father or His father on earth.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester

K.15 *Who died on the Cross for our sins?* Jesus died on the Cross for our sins, rose from the dead, and He went up to Heaven so we can live with God forever in Heaven.

K.16 *Who founded the Catholic Church? Why?* Jesus founded the Catholic Church to teach us about God, to give us grace, and to help us get to heaven.

K.17 *What happens when we are baptized?* We become members of the Catholic Church and original sin and any sin we have committed is wiped away when we are baptized.
