

Classes/Meetings are directed by the Coordinator of Youth Apostolate and guided by the Pastor and Parochial Vicar. As the primary duty, right, and obligation of the parent is to properly instruct, guide, and form the youth, it is understood that all classes are supplemental and secondary to the instruction and example of the parent. **High School Youth Group meetings are weekly on Saturdays at 6:30-8:30pm following the 5:30pm vigil Mass.** This typically includes Dinner, Prayer, Class, and Social Activities. There are also times throughout the year that guest speakers may be called upon to speak on specific topics of relevance. Times and activities can be modified at the discretion of the Director of Youth Apostolate under the direction of the Pastor and Parochial Vicar.

Activities of Social, Spiritual, and Service-oriented focus are regularly organized and coordinated throughout the year by the Director of Youth Apostolate for the benefit of the youth. These activities are truly a service offered to the youth. If for any reason it becomes apparent these services are not needed nor desired by the youth(s) and parent(s), the Director of Youth Apostolate reserves the right to suspend all Parish-supported Youth Activities. Any activity outside the regular activities *on the Parish Premises* will require a dated permission slip to be signed by the parent(s) of the youth involved. Parents may offer their assistance at any time and are encouraged to do so. Activities include, but are not limited to: retreats, movie nights, paintball, bowling outings, skating trips, fundraisers, praying together, soup suppers, community clean-ups, sporting events, and music and drama productions. Other fees may be applicable for activities and events. These amounts, if any, will be noted on permission slips and returned along with the permission slips prior to youth participation in activities.

Sacramental Students: All youth (including Non-Catholics) interested in participating in the Youth Program are more than welcome; however, the High School Religious Education Program will not be preparing students for the reception of any sacraments.

Tuition: The High School Youth Group Fee is \$30.00 This fee covers books, supplies, and copy materials for the whole year. *If tuition presents a financial hardship, please contact the Director of Youth Apostolate.*
