Confessions: One half hour before every Mass and by appointment in the Church.

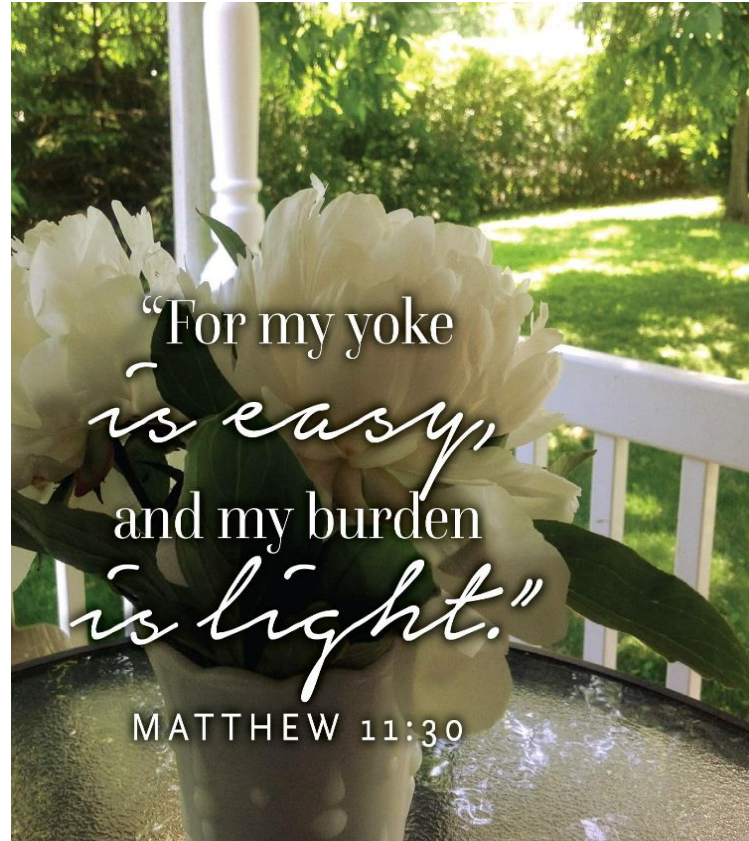
Baptism: Call the Parish Office and schedule the date and time for pre-baptismal instructions.
