Baptism: Call the Parish Office and schedule the date and time for pre-baptismal instructions.

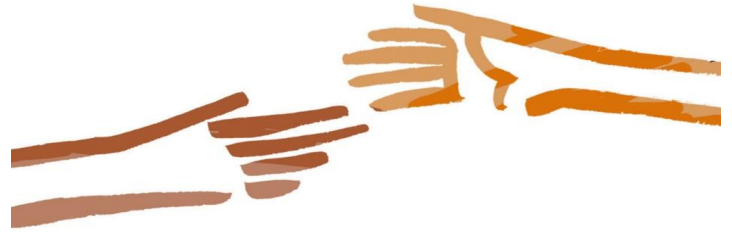
Marriage: Premarital preparations need a minimum of 9 months before your wedding date. Contact the Priest in advance.
