WEDDING DAY REQUIREMENTS

Please review the following directives from the Archdiocese of Chicago. These are set out to make sure all in attendance remain safe and healthy during the wedding.

- The door to enter is the northwest covered door of the church. The doors will open 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the wedding.
- The bride and groom do not need to wear masks. Everyone else in the wedding party and all attendees must wear masks covering their mouth and nose while in the Basilica, except children under 2 years of age.
- If anyone is ill who planned to attend, have them stay home.
- Following the protocols of the city of Chicago and state of Illinois a maximum of 150 attendees are allowed which includes the bridal party. Should the current situation regarding the pandemic change we will notify of the updated guidelines from the city of Chicago and state of Illinois.
- You must have 2 ushers who can seat people in the designated areas of the pews, and they must attend the rehearsal.
- Please bring to your rehearsal a list of all wedding guests with contact information to hand over to Queen of All Saints Basilica.
