WHAT IS A MARRIAGE ANNULMENT? Have you ever wondered why Catholics require Marriage Annulments or how the process works? There will be a Marriage Annulment Information Presentation at St. John Catholic Church, 1900 West Main Street, on November 21, 2020, at 1 PM in the Parish Hall. Amanda Crawford from the Diocesan Catholic Tribunal will be the guest speaker. COVID-19 protocol will be followed, masks and social distancing.

Plenary Indulgence during month of November: Due to the coronavirus pandemic and the need to avoid large groups from forming where prohibited, the Plenary Indulgence applicable to the deceased by those who visit a cemetery has been extended beyond the normal dates of 1 to 8 November. This year, the indulgence can be obtained by anyone who visits a cemetery, even if only mentally, on any day in November, and devoutly prays for the faithful departed. The usual conditions of confession and Eucharist within a reasonable time as well as praying for the intentions of Pope Francis apply.

COVID-19: Please remember: 1) If you are not feeling well, stay at home especially on Sundays; 2) Always wear a mask when in public. This includes Church Services; 3) Practice social distancing. Doing these accomplishes two ends: Protects others from oneself; AND protects oneself from others.
