**THANKSGIVING DAY:** Mass for Thanksgiving Day will be celebrated at 9:30 a.m. Although our nation is experiencing a goodly amount of turmoil there is still reason for giving thanks on this day.

**ADVENT, 2020:** Advent, the season of preparation to celebrate Christmas, begins next Sunday, **Nov 29**. Advent meditation booklets, *The Word Among Us*, are available at the church entrances. You are encouraged to take one home with you. There are 75 copies available. Please limit one per family!

**ADVENT PENANCE SERVICE:** The Advent Penance Service will be celebrated December 6 at 7 p.m. in church.

**MASS INTENTIONS:** Requesting Masses to be offered for a person, intention, or occasion during the coming year, 2021 increases the opportunity to request a desired date. Intentions will be honored on a first-come, first-serve basis. Dates in 2021 may be requested, with the exception of Sundays which are reserved for parishioners of Holy Redeemer. The usual offering is \$10.00. Please submit all requests in writing giving intention, donor, and date requested.

**Plenary Indulgence during month of November:** Due to the coronavirus pandemic and the need to avoid large groups from forming where prohibited, the Plenary Indulgence applicable to the deceased by those who visit a cemetery has been extended beyond the normal dates of 1 to 8 November. This year, the indulgence can be obtained by anyone who visits a cemetery, even if only mentally, on any day in November, and devoutly prays for the faithful departed. The usual conditions of confession and Eucharist within a reasonable time as well as praying for the intentions of Pope Francis apply.

**COVID-19:** Please remember: 1) If you are not feeling well, stay at home especially on Sundays; 2) Always wear a mask when in public. This includes Church Services; 3) Practice social distancing. Doing these accomplishes two ends: Protects others from oneself; AND protects oneself from others.

**BUILDING FUND ENVELOPE:** The yellow envelope—Building Fund—will no longer be included in the monthly envelope mailing to parishioners beginning with the January, 2021 mailing. A blue envelope, similar to what has been posted on the bulletin board at the church entrances, will be included in the monthly mailing.
