**PRE Enrollment:** This year classes will be online. Our priority is for those students in sacrament preparation. Grades 1 and 2, Year I and II for Older students include 1st Reconciliation & 1st Communion preparation. Grades 8 and 9 include Confirmation Preparation. Registration for 2020-2021 will begin Tuesday August 24 to September 11 in the Education Center from 6 to 9 p.m. Classes will begin Sunday, September 13, 2020. Changes to schedule will be posted immediately on parish Facebook page and website. All students must register and pay a \$15.00 registration fee which helps reduce the cost of textbooks and resources for the PRE program. The parish covers the remainder of textbook expense. More information regarding classes will be given out next weekend.

**COVID-19:** Please remember: 1) If you do not feel good, stay at home especially on Sundays; 2) Always wear a mask when in public. This includes Church Services; 3) Practice social distancing. Doing these accomplishes two ends: Protects others from oneself; AND protects oneself from others.

**BAPTISMS:** Contact the pastor well in advance of proposed date for baptism.

**MARRIAGES:** The 6-month preparation period is still required. Hopefully by late this year or early next year restrictions will have been lifted.

**CENSUS 2020:** The Census Bureau has shortened the time for completing the Census. Counting people will end on September 30, one month earlier than originally stated. IF YOU HAVE NOT COMPLETED THE CENSUS REPORT, PLEASE GO TO [2020census.gov/en/ways-to-respond.org](http://2020census.gov/en/ways-to-respond.org) TO COMPLETE THE ONLINE FORM. The U.S. Constitution requires a counting of the population living in the U.S. be completed every ten years. The census is used to determine the amount of federal dollars—our tax dollars—shared by states and local governments for education, public safety, roads, and social services. The census also determines how many Representatives from each state to the House of Representatives in Washington DC. The number of representatives and the funds for each state will not be reviewed for another ten years. Remember, we will all have to live the results for another ten years.

**VOTING 2020:** Voting in an election, regardless of party affiliation, is a right and responsibility that should not be taken for granted or treated casually. If one has not registered the link below addresses this. As has been explained in the media, voting has several options. One is to vote in person on Election Day. Another is to vote absentee or mail-in. Voting absentee has been made easier with the governor stating fear of COVID-19 is a valid excuse for absentee voting. Lastly, one can vote early.
