Submit the application to the rectory. 2) Register for Protecting God's Children at virtusonline.org. You can take this workshop at any location, but must submit your certificate of attendance to the rectory. When registering, please DO NOT request your background check. That will be done in house. 3) Once you receive a letter stating that your background check has been completed, you will then be certified to volunteer. For existing volunteers, you will be notified when you are up for recertification. The next Keeping the Promise Alive workshop will be on Wednesday, September 8 at 7 pm in the Community Room.

The scriptures begin with God's affirmation that all of creation is "very good," and as the stewards of God's creation, we are called to protect and nurture its goodness (Genesis 1:30, Genesis 1:28, Jeremiah 29:5-7). Every species, indeed all of creation, is precious because God made them.

A suggestion that all of us could do as our action to sustain Our Common Home is **plant a tree**. **Trees are simply amazing**. They clean air and water, slow climate change, ease poverty and hunger, prevent species loss, and feed the human soul. All we need to do is plant and care for them. Let's work together to make it happen.

Over the course of 50 years, a single tree can generate \$31,250 worth of air pollution control, recycle \$37,500 worth of water, and control \$31,500 worth of soil erosion. Where else could we get such a return on our investment?
