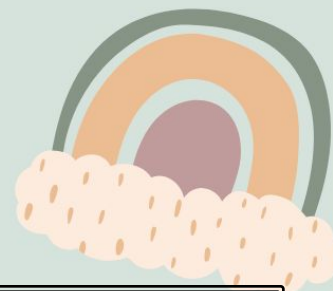


Mrs. Austin's P5 Newsletter for week ending
