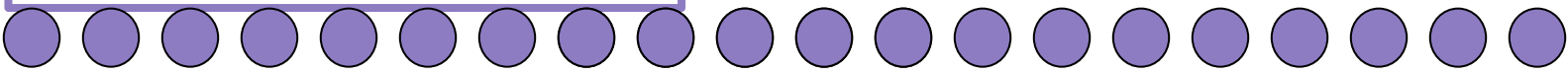
**A Message from the Teacher:**
