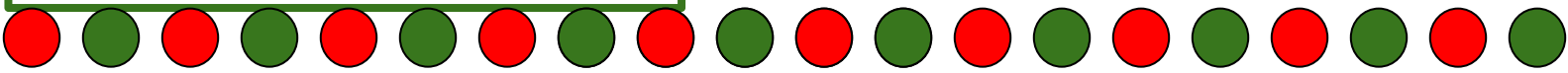
A Message from the Teacher:
