HERE'S WHAT'S HAPPENIN'

SIXTH GRADE

Math— One group is working on areas of different figures. We are showing how the area of a figure is derived from other figures. The other group is working on algebraic expressions and solving simple algebraic equations using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. On Wednesday we are working on all aspects of fractions.

Vocabulary— We will start vocabulary lesson 10. The test over lesson 8 will be on **Friday, February 12th.**

SEVENTH GRADE

Math— One of the groups is working on solving algebraic inequalities using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The other group is working on translations in a coordinate plane, congruent figures, and similar figures. On Wednesday we are studying statistics and probability.

Vocabulary— We will start vocabulary lesson 10. The test over lesson 8 will be on **Friday, February 12th.**

EIGHTH GRADE

Blue Math— We are studying linear equations. Some of the topics involve graphing equations, slope-intercept form of equations, and standard form of equations. One Wednesday we are studying statistics and probability.

Purple Math— Functions is the topic of the day. Studying the domain, range, and slope of a function along with discrete and continuous domains is going to be the challenge. The students are really working hard on these lessons and it is paying off. On Wednesday we are studying probability and statistics using the IXL program.
