 through a gracious donor!

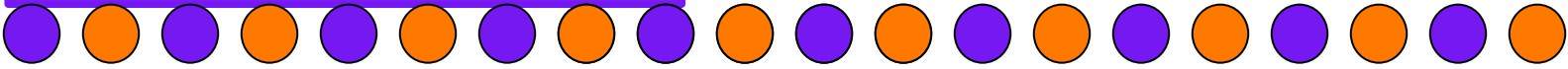
