~Attached to this newsletter is our class code as well as ordering information for our class Scholastic Book Club. Our order due date for March is **March 12th**.

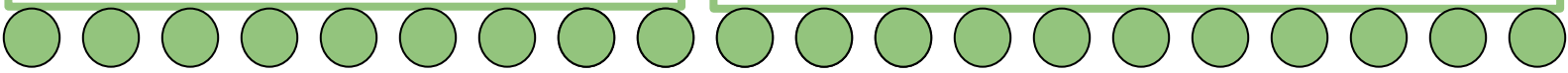
- In past months we have had a few families donate for each student to receive a new book! Students will be receiving a book February, March, and April! If you would like to take part in this, please send me an email.
