Thank you for your patience. As noted last night in our meeting, I had forgotten to upload and send out the Google Form for January's homework.

In January's Class, we talked about the 10 Commandments, and gave examples of them and how we can follow them. The Google Form for this assignment asks students to choose which definition best fits into each commandment.
