Holy Thursday - 9 April @ 7 pm

Good Friday - 10 April @ 3 pm

Easter Vigil - 11 April @ 8 pm

Easter Sunday - 12 April @ 10:30 am

I will be privately celebrating the Triduum Liturgies (*except for the Easter Vigil*) here at Holy Cross, Kemptville at the same time that the Archbishop is celebrating the liturgies at the Cathedral.

In addition to our **Parish Sunday Masses** (available online on Saturday evenings by 5 pm). A recording of Holy Cross Masses for **Holy Thursday**, **Good Friday** and **Easter Sunday** will be available on our Facebook page and web page at the date and times indicated above. Please note that you do not have to have Facebook to access the masses. In this way, we can prayerfully be united in our homes to celebrate the most Sacred Liturgies of our Faith together.
